Rabies Surveillance: 2006

- 49 states reported cases of rabies
 - Hawaii only "rabies free" state
 - Overall incidence up 8.2% since 2005
- 3 human cases; 6940 animal cases
 - 92% wild animals
 - 38% raccoons, 24% bats, 21.5% skunks, 6% foxes
 - -8% domestic animals
 - Number of cat cases usually 3 4 X number of dog or cattle cases
 - PA had largest # of cases: 72; VA was 2nd with 62





Figure 1—Distribution of major rabies virus variants among wild terrestrial reservoirs in the United States and Puerto Rico.
